Dr. Thomas G. Ranney, Professor, Department of Horticultural Science,
North Carolina State University

Dr. Ranney's research program focuses on the evaluation, selection, and development of new landscape and bioenergy crops. These efforts involve an ongoing search for new plants that provide economic opportunities for the green industry and a foundation for further plant breeding. Recent plant developments from his program include new hybrid Hydrangea. He has served in editorial positions for various publications and has received numerous awards from the Journal of the American Society for Horticultural Science. He has been awarded for outstanding scientific research from the American Horticultural Society.
